Tips for Romance and Love

A Feng Shui Master who advised a Chinese family during the ancient times in China is privy to all the secrets of the family. He is the person who is given great trust and responsibility to ensure that the health, happiness, prosperity and wellbeing of the family and their future descendants

are being addressed for the year when he is consulted annually on the Feng Shui of their home. Even the delicate and sensitive issues of romance, husband hunting and fidelity in marriage are his responsibilities. The Feng Shui Master has many “tips up his sleeve” to address these areas of concern as he advises parents of young maidens on husband hunting and young married couples on how to keep the marriage alive.

In Chinese culture, the Peony flower is regarded as the “king of flowers.” It is symbolic of wondrous good fortune and also associated with attractive and beautiful women. Its beauty is linked to the legendary concubine of one of China's emperors. This concubine was regarded as one of the most beautiful women in Chinese history. As the story goes, she was the emperor's favorite concubine until his death and her beauty was compared to that of a peony flower, which was a flower she was quite fond of. As such, she decorated her bedchamber with beautiful peony flowers all through the year. The emperor would order these flowers from the South during the cold winter months to grace her bedchamber during that time so that she would always be surrounded by them.

In many Chinese homes in Asia, parents who want their daughters to find the right partner in marriage will hang large paintings of peonies in their living rooms. They believe that in hanging these paintings or displaying these colorful live peony blooms, their daughters would find good, loving and wealthy husbands. Besides the symbolism of being able to attract young suitors for their single and marriageable daughters, these families would also benefit from the magnificence of the peony flower and receive the good fortune that this flower provides.

Feng Shui Masters would advise such families to display their live or silk peony flowers or paintings of these flowers at the southern sector of the home. Decorating this area with these auspicious flowers will create wonderful romance and relationship luck.

My Feng Shui Master's favorite tip for the single lady of marriageable age is to hang a painting of peonies in her bedroom or to hang a live or silk peony flower just outside her bedroom door. This is a powerful way to attract a husband. However, this should be done with great caution as once this single lady is married this painting of peonies cannot remain in the bedroom as it would have negative consequences.

Another tip is for the single girl to hang a painting of a pair of Mandarin ducks together or display a wooden pair of them in her bedroom. These should be placed in the Southwest corner of the bedroom. It is very important that only a pair is displayed and that the pair is made up of a male and a female duck. Mandarin ducks in Feng Shui represents the luck and happiness of romance, young love and fidelity for young couples.

Once you have found someone special and that person is having problems making a commitment or in proposing marriage, another favorite Feng Shui advice is to display a crystal in the Southwest sector. To strengthen, enhance and activate this crystal, a bright light is also placed in the Southwest sector. This light is turned on every night for at least three hours. Crystals in the Southwest create greater harmony and happiness in all types of relationships especially those special relationships with loved ones. The Southwest sector governs the luck of love, romance and family happiness.

For the newly married couple, it would be most fitting to display a pair of wooden ducks in the Southwest sector of their home as this promotes deep love and fidelity between husband and wife. Paintings in the bedroom of married couples should be that of children and ripe fruits to depict the wonderful result of their pairing and creating auspicious descendants luck.

The Southwest sector is seen as the universal sector for relationship and romance luck. However, if one wants to be even more precise, then one can specially energize and activate one's personal relationship sector based on the calculation of Feng Shui's Eight Mansions Kua numbers for each individual. This would produce an even more potent energizer to enhance love and romance in your life!
